VENDOR PLANNING INFORMATION

We are thrilled about your interest in becoming a vendor at Market in the Mountains! Please read through these important planning information points to be sure that our market works as smoothly as possible.



SET UP/TAKE DOWN

- Set up date is September 20th.
- Vendor arrival is PRIOR TO 9:00am on September 21st, gates open for customers at 10:00am.
- Vendor arrival is TBD on 09/22/2024. No early pack-up is permitted on 9/22.

FEES: \$250 VENDOR FEE

- All fees are non-refundable, and nontransferable.
- Pricing and specific booth type will be selected AFTER your application is processed.

APPLICATIONS

- All potential Vendors must fill out a complete application.
- Not all vendors are accepted in order to curate the best possible market experience.
- We do not accept MLM vendors.



FAQ'S

Will I have to provide proof of liability insurance for my booth?

Yes, at check in you will have to provide a copy of your business insurance to receive your spot assignment and be allowed to set up.

Can I share a booth or have a featured trunk show?

Yes you can! It requires an application from all parties (the main booth vendor and the split or trunk show). The contract will have an option to pay for trunk show space/booth sharing at a reduced price. This way both parties are receiving the information emails on set up and parking etc., and holding a spot in promotional materials. If you want to ensure your business is being advertised and receiving email communications, you must complete an application.

Can I request a specific spot?

You can let us know If you have a specific need (ie, another business will watch your booth etc. And we will try our hardest to accommodate that.



FAQ'S

Where can I stay?

You can dry camp In the field for no additional charge. There Is a building with a shower that is available only on a first come, first serve basis,. As well as an outdoor non-potable water source to fill up trailer tanks.

There are numerous AirBNB/VRBO rentals nearby (search for Loon lake, Waitts Lake, Valley or Springdale WA. to be within about 15 minutes).

There Is a new hotel In Chewelah WA Mistequa that Is approximately 25 min to the ranch, and a hotel In Airway Heights, WA Northern Quest which Is about 45 minutes to the ranch.

I didn't get accepted last year, should I still apply this year?

Absolutely! Sometimes we simply cannot justify adding another business in a specific category because It would overwhelm the market balance. Sometimes vendors that have previously attended are unable to make this years market because of family obligations. If you want to be there, then please apply!



FAQ'S

I know someone else that would be a great business to have at Market In the Mountains what should I do?

Have them apply, and tell them to put down your business for the referral. If you're both accepted you'll get \$50 credited back on your invoice and it helps me to know that a new business is recommended by someone we trust.

Do you have any tips for me as the Market owner?

FAQ'S

I want to be featured in the fashion show but was not planning to be a vendor, can I do that?

No not this year. We will be focusing on sourcing our fashion show outfits directly from the businesses at Market. In order to have your items featured you must be an accepted vendor.

I'm planning on starting a business but I won't have all my information before applications are due, should I still apply?

You need to have your company name, tax registration information (UBI, EIN, or state equivalent), and what you will be offering by the application deadline. You do not need vendor liability insurance until arrival at market.

I saw someone at Market last year, and they sold the same thing I do. Are they automatically accepted for this year, or should I apply?

You should absolutely apply! Depending on the variety of applicants we may have room for more than one of each type. You also don't know if they are applying this year. They may have a scheduling conflict for 2024, or may have changed their business model.
